Children of incarcerated parents often have no tangible evidence that their parent loves them. All they know is they are gone.

An Angel Tree gift at Christmas from their incarcerated parent lets them know that they do in fact have a loving parent. This "Angel Tree Connection" is often what allows returning parents to begin reuniting with their children and families.
